Pinot Noir, planted 1966, 1.04 ha in Concoeur (Hautes-Côtes de Nuits), Concoeur-et-Corboin. Above Vosne, planted east-west, clay-limestone and silt soil. 100% de-stemmed, 1-week cool maceration (10°C), minimal punch-downs, aged for 15 months in used barrels, racked once before bottling. This parcel is just at the beginning of the Hautes-Côtes in Concoeur, where the grapes mature at a similar rate to those in the Côte de Nuits. Vines are pruned to a Guyot Simple and harvest is by hand with yields of about 45 hL per hectare.

THE PRODUCER

Domaine Jean Tardy

A six-hectare family domaine in Vosne-Romanée, worked by father and son. Ten red wines from old Pinot Noir vines — some planted in 1929 and 1937 — across nine climats from Fixin to Comblanchien, including Echézeaux Grand Cru Les Treux. Sustainable farming, fully de-stemmed fruit, gentle extraction, and long ageing in barrel.
