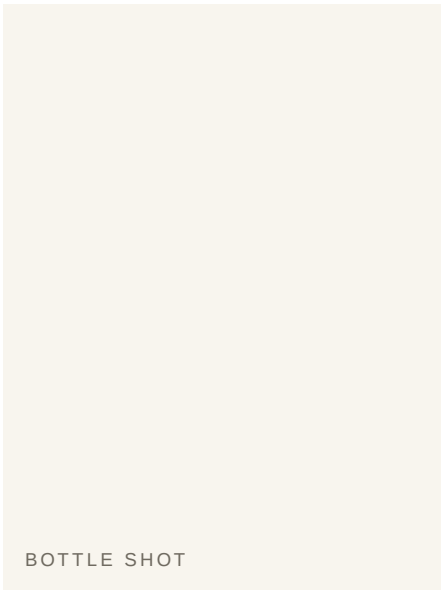

50% Pinot Noir, 50% Gamay, planted 1968, 0.76 ha in Flagey-Echézeaux / Vosne-Romanée (regional parcel), Flagey-Echézeaux. Near the villages of Flagey-Echezeaux and Vosne-Romanée, east and west-facing, clay-limestone soil. 100% de-stemmed, mostly pump-overs with a few punch-downs, aged for 12+ months in used barrels (40%) and in stainless steel (60%), racked once before bottling.

THE PRODUCER

Domaine Jean Tardy

A six-hectare family domaine in Vosne-Romanée, worked by father and son. Ten red wines from old Pinot Noir vines — some planted in 1929 and 1937 — across nine climats from Fixin to Comblanchien, including Echézeaux Grand Cru Les Treux. Sustainable farming, fully de-stemmed fruit, gentle extraction, and long ageing in barrel.
