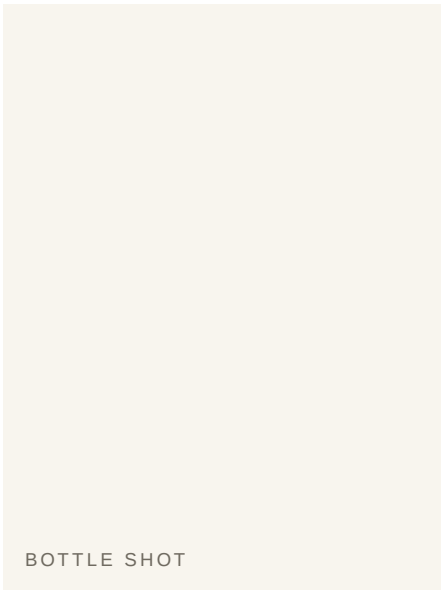

# Côte de Nuits-Villages Aux Boulardes 2023

Pinot Noir, planted 1966–1969 and 1989, 1.39 ha in Aux Boulardes, Comblanchien. From Comblanchien, silty-clay limestone. De-stemmed, not crushed, 1-week cool maceration, 3-week ambient yeast fermentation, minimal punch-downs and pump-overs, aged for 16–18 months in barrels (25% new).

## Domaine Jean Tardy

A six-hectare family domaine in Vosne-Romanée, worked by father and son. Ten red wines from old Pinot Noir vines — some planted in 1929 and 1937 — across nine climats from Fixin to Comblanchien, including Echézeaux Grand Cru Les Treux. Sustainable farming, fully de-stemmed fruit, gentle extraction, and long ageing in barrel.
