Pinot Noir, planted 1937, 0.34 ha in Les Treux (Echézeaux), Flagey-Echézeaux. Next to Grands Echézeaux, little to no slope, planted from east to west, clay-limestone soil. 100% de-stemmed (65% whole berries), minimal punch-downs. Aged 18 months in barrels (20% one-year-old, 80% new), racked once before bottling. Vines in this parcel are pruned to the traditional Burgundian Guyot simple. Harvest is entirely by hand with yields of approximately 33 hL per hectare.

THE PRODUCER

Domaine Jean Tardy

A six-hectare family domaine in Vosne-Romanée, worked by father and son. Ten red wines from old Pinot Noir vines — some planted in 1929 and 1937 — across nine climats from Fixin to Comblanchien, including Echézeaux Grand Cru Les Treux. Sustainable farming, fully de-stemmed fruit, gentle extraction, and long ageing in barrel.
