

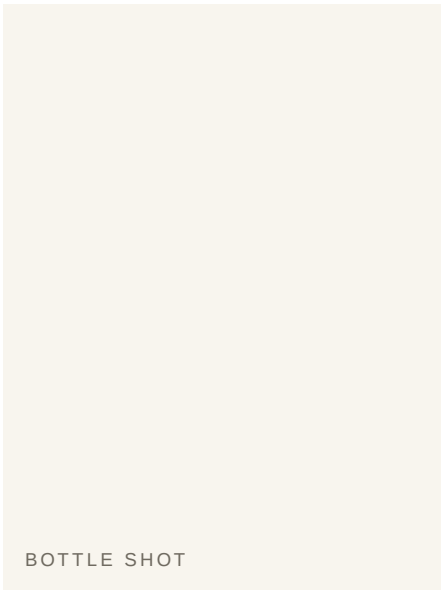
Domaine Jean Tardy

Pinot Noir, planted 1973, 0.41 ha in La Place, Fixin. From upper Fixin, facing east to west, gentle slope, silt and clay soil with limestone. Careful de-stemming (65% whole berries), cold pre-fermentation maceration (10°C), minimal punch-downs. Aged 16 months in barrels (70% one-year-old, 30% new), raked once before bottling. Vines are pruned to Guyot simple. Harvest is entirely by hand with yields of about 36 hL per hectare.

THE PRODUCER

Domaine Jean Tardy

A six-hectare family domaine in Vosne-Romanée, worked by father and son. Ten red wines from old Pinot Noir vines — some planted in 1929 and 1937 — across nine climats from Fixin to Comblanchien, including Echézeaux Grand Cru Les Treux. Sustainable farming, fully de-stemmed fruit, gentle extraction, and long ageing in barrel.
