Pinot Noir, planted 1958, 0.30 ha in Champenot, Gevrey-Chambertin. Shallow clay and silt soil with limestone. 100% de-stemmed (65% whole berries), minimal punch-downs. Aged 16 months in barrels (67% one-year-old, 33% new), racked once before bottling.

THE PRODUCER

Domaine Jean Tardy

A six-hectare family domaine in Vosne-Romanée, worked by father and son. Ten red wines from old Pinot Noir vines — some planted in 1929 and 1937 — across nine climats from Fixin to Comblanchien, including Echézeaux Grand Cru Les Treux. Sustainable farming, fully de-stemmed fruit, gentle extraction, and long ageing in barrel.
